PHOTOGRAPHY COURSES

Terms and Conditions

The photography courses (hereinafter the "Course" or "Courses") provided by Andrew Johnstone (hereinafter the "Course Provider") for clients (hereinafter the "Client") are subject to the following terms and conditions.

1. To reserve a place on the Course, the Client should send an e-mail to the Course Provider, requesting the number of places and availability for the dates required. All Courses are offered subject to the availability of the Course Provider and planned accommodation.
2. Upon confirmation of availability from the Course Provider and in order to book a place on the course, the Client shall arrange immediate payment of a non-refundable deposit of €75 per place on a group course and €200 per place on an individual course. Following receipt of the request and deposit, the Course Provider shall send the Client a confirmation invoice. This is the formal acceptance of the booking and shall include the dates that have been agreed.
3. The balance of the Course fees is payable not less than 3 weeks before the start of the Course. If payment is not received by the due date, the Course Provider reserves the right to give notice in writing that the reservation is cancelled. Reservations made within 3 weeks of the start of the Course require full payment at the time of booking.
4. Subject to clauses 2 & 3 above, in the event of a non-insurable cancellation, refunds of amounts paid shall be made if the Course Provider is able to fill the place, and any expenses or losses incurred in so doing shall be deducted from the refundable amount.
5. The accommodation included in the advertised cost of the photo courses is at La Pigario, Saur, 81310 France. The accommodation can be reviewed on line at www.lapigario.com. The accommodation is own, run and offered by Isabelle and Daniel Delessert and the Course Provider is not responsible for any aspect of the accommodation provided. The Client is requested to behave responsibly and respectfully when staying at La Pigario. Should the accommodation offered be busy at the time of booking, the Course Provider will attempt to provide an alternate accommodation, though there may be a surcharge for this.
6. The Client is responsible for making his/her own travel arrangements to ensure that they are able to participate in the Course they have booked. The Course Provider recommends in good faith certain transport options for the Client, but does not take responsibility for the quality of service provided by these suppliers. The Course Provider shall not be liable for any cancellations or alterations to the travel services or accommodation that the Client organises or books in order to attend the Course.
7. The Client is strongly advised to have adequate insurance for all eventualities (illness, accidents, cancellation, transport delays and loss or damage to personal belongings, including photographic equipment) as the Course Provider shall not be held liable for any loss, damage to the client's equipment or possessions or for additional costs incurred during the Course. The

Client is also advised to bring a National Insurance Health Card and/or proof of medical insurance cover.

8. Clients should be fit enough to participate in photographic excursions which may include some gentle hiking in recognised tourist areas. The Course Provider recommends that all Clients should come equipped with a sunhat, walking shoes (or other suitable footwear), rain jacket, sun-cream and a water bottle. Long trousers are recommended.

8. The Client shall be responsible for providing his/her own photographic equipment for use during the course. Some photographic equipment is available for hire, but the Client must give the Course Provider adequate warning of their requirements, preferably on booking the course.

9. The Course Provider shall not be liable to the Client for any temporary defect in respect of any equipment, plant, machinery or appliance pertaining to the Course, nor for any loss, damage or injury which is the result of adverse weather conditions, riot, war, strikes or any other force majeure circumstances beyond the control of the Course Provider. The Course Provider shall not be held responsible for any damage to the Client's own photographic equipment.

10. The Course Provider reserves the right to change the itinerary of the Course.

11. The Course Provider shall make every effort to ensure that the Courses booked proceed as planned. However, if the Course Provider is forced to cancel the Course for reasons beyond his control (force majeure) then the Client shall be offered an alternative Course date or can opt to receive a full refund of the monies paid for the Course booked and the Course Provider shall have no further liability. In the event of cancellation of the Course by the Course Provider, the Course Provider shall not be liable for costs incurred by the Client for accommodation or travel fares made to attend the Course.

12. By paying the required deposit to book a Course, the Client is confirming his/her agreement to all these terms and conditions without exception.
